MARCUS PUMPKIN (Cold Hardy)

Mexican Varieties (aka HAAS type)

Winter Mexican (Cold Hardy)

Winter Mexican variety is one of most cold hardy varieties. Mature trees may withstand temperatures in the mid 20s. Oblong fruit, 12 to 18 Oz, thick green skin, medium seed. Very vigorous tree, bears heavily and regularly in the winter unlike most that produce in the fall. Originated in Palm Beach, Florida.

Mexican Varieties (aka HAAS type)

BACON (Cold Hardy)

'BACON' IS A MEXICAN TYPE AVOCADO LIKE HAAS. THE FRUIT IS SLIGHTLY LARGER HOWEVER WITH A DARK GREEN ALMOST BLACK SKIN. THE FRUIT EATS VERY WELL HAVING A RICH CREAMY FLAVOR AND A SKIN THAT PEELS QUITE EASILY. IT IS A MINOR COMMERCIAL VARIETY IN CALIFORNIA, AND IT DOES HAVE SOME HISTORY HERE IN FLORIDA AS WELL.



BACON

Season: September - October

Fruit Size 12 - 16 oz

Flower Type: B

Tree Size: 30' x 20'



Mexican Varieties (aka HAAS type)

LILA (Cold Hardy)

The Lila Avocado Tree is a smaller, semi-dwarf tree. This Mexican variety grows to around 10 feet tall at maturity and can be easily maintained at 5 feet. This is great for growing the avocado tree in a patio container. Can take temperatures down to 15F for short period of time without significant damage.
