



Mangos

CARRIE

IS A FIBERLESS FLORIDA CULTIVAR THAT IS SICKENING SWEET AND DELICIOUS AS CAN BE. ITS COMPACT SIZE MAKES IT AN EXCELLENT DOORYARD TREE THAT REQUIRES MINIMAL CARE. BOTH FRUIT AND TREE HAVE LITTLE TO NO PROBLEM WITH FUNGUS OR DISEASE. LACK OF COLOR AND FIRMNESS ARE THE ONLY SHORTCOMINGS OF THIS SUPERB VARIETY. THE FRUIT RIPENS FROM JUNE TO JULY.

COGSHALL

THIS "**CONDO MANGO**" IS AN ULTRA COMPACT GROWER THAT PRODUCES SWEET FIBERLESS FRUIT. THE TREE IS SUITABLE FOR CONTAINER GROWING ON A BALCONY, OR PLANTING IN A SUBURBAN BACKYARD. IT CAN EASILY BE MAINTAINED AT JUST EIGHT FEET TALL, AND IT WILL STILL PRODUCE A GOOD SIZE CROP YEAR AFTER YEAR. THE FRUIT RIPENS FROM JUNE TO JULY. CONDO MANGO

GLENN

"GLENN" IS A HADEN SEEDLING, AND MUCH LIKE THE HADEN IT IS A FLORIDA FAVORITE. THE FRUIT HAS A MILD PEACHY FLAVOR WHICH IS BOTH SWEET AND DELICIOUS. IT IS OF EXCELLENT EATING QUALITY, CONSISTENT PRODUCTION, AND EFFORTLESS TO GROW. TREES ARE TYPICALLY FIFTEEN FEET TALL WITH A ROUNDED DENSELY FOLIATED CANOPY. THE FRUIT RIPENS JUNE TO JULY MAKING IT OUR MOST POPULAR EARLY SEASON MANGO.

MALLIKA

"MALLIKA" IS A "**CONDO MANGO**" NATIVE TO INDIA. IT HAS BECOME A FAVORITE HERE DUE TO ITS SUPERB FLAVOR, UNPARALLELED DISEASE RESISTANCE, AND SMALL BUT EXTREMELY PRODUCTIVE HABIT. THERE IS A CATCH, HOWEVER. THE FRUIT MUST BE PICKED MATURE GREEN FOR OPTIMUM FLAVOR, AND THEY ARE TRADITIONALLY RIPENED IN CAMEL DUNG WHILE ON THE WAY TO MARKET IN INDIA. THEY CAN ALSO BE PACKED IN A CARDBOARD BOX AND KEPT AT ROOM TEMPERATURE IF CAMEL DUNG IS DIFFICULT TO COME BY IN YOUR PART OF THE WORLD. RIPENING TYPICALLY TAKES TEN TO FOURTEEN DAYS. THE SEASON IS FROM JUNE TO JULY.
